Institutional Compliance Solutions: Title IX University

Complete the “Course Information & Registration” form on the “Gender Equality (Title IX) webpage (www.sde.idaho.gov/topics/gender-equality/) under the “Training” section. Once that is complete you will be added to Title IX University.

- **Courses:** Title IX Basics course as a prerequisite for all of the courses. From there, Coordinators will focus on the Coordinator course; Investigators the Investigator course; and so on. Team members should look for the course that coordinates with their role within the Title IX process. This learning system promotes cross-learning, so all courses will be available to all users.
 - You will have access to all of the courses (2020 & 2024) and all of the roles. Due to the injunction, Idaho is not required to implement the 2024 regulations at this time. The courses are there in the event the injunction is lifted.
- **2020 Title IX Process Survival Kit** is comparable to the ATIXA TIXKIT. If you are uncertain what that is, stay tuned for information about it.
 - The Report Triage Tool (2.5) and the Individualized Safety Assessment Tool (2.51) are tools the Title IX Coordinator might want to use will working on complaints.
 - There is a video explaining the Triage Tool. Use the password “ics” to access it.
 - It says that it is a course, but it really isn’t.
 - The Individualized Safety Assessment also has a video and uses “ics” password.
 - The Process Survival Kit has a variety of forms, flowcharts, and procedures to help with implementation of the Title IX requirements.
- **ICS Compliance Aids and Resources (K-12)** has an FAQ section and links to previous Newsletters/Zoom Takeaways/Webinars
- **2020 Title IX Process Survival Kit (Spanish Translation)** has the documents and resources translated for use with complaints and investigations.
